HISTORY AND SPIRITUALITY IN JERUSALEM'S OLD CITY

- 9:00 a.m. Meet Andrea Handler, Tour Guide, in front of King David Hotel (23 King David Street)
- Introduction in Bloomfield Park or (Mishkenot Sheananim) Windmill
- Proceed along the walls of the Old City to Mt. Zion
- Visit Mt. Zion sites including Dormition Abbey, King David's Tomb, Cenacle
- Walk through Zion Gate into Old City
- Four Quarters' Lookout (above Chabad Street)
- Explore Jewish Quarter and visit archaeological treasures and other highlights, among them:
 - The Cardo, the main street of Byzantine Jerusalem in the 6th century
 - King Hezekiah's First Temple-period "Broad Wall"
 - Hurva Square, the central square of the Jewish Quarter
 - Batei Machase Square
- Stop at the Kotel (Western Wall) and experience the special atmosphere of this holy site
- View of Southern Wall excavations, Hulda Gates, etc.
- Walk through Muslim Quarter to lunch stopping at Cotton Merchants Market for close-up view of Dome of the Rock
- 13:00-14:15 Lunch at Abu Shukri (reserved) near 5th Station of the Cross
- Visit Church of the Holy Sepulchre highlights, among them:
 - Hill of Golgotha
 - Stone of Unction
 - Grave of Adam
 - Discovery of the True Cross
- Walk through the bustling souq, the marketplace of the Muslim Quarter, to Jaffa Gate
